ROLL CALL/CALL TO ORDER/ PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

President George called the regular Village Council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Council Chambers located at 18500 W. Thirteen Mile Road, Beverly Hills, MI 48025. Brown called the roll. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Motion by Hrydziusko, second by O’Gorman, to excuse Kecskemeti from tonight’s meeting.

Motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS ON ITEMS NOT ON PUBLISHED AGENDA

Jameela Hepburn, Franklin Resident, addressed Council regarding difficulty determining which jurisdiction was responsible for building and permit assistance for her property. She explained that she had been directed among Franklin, Southfield, and Beverly Hills and had not received clear responses to calls or emails. She stated that her retaining wall project was being treated as a deck and asked for clarification and accountability.

Theresa Caverly, Beverly Road, followed up on concerns she had raised at the last Council meeting regarding speeding and traffic volume on Beverly Road between Greenfield and Southfield.

David Tababen, Orchard Way Court, requested that the April 14, 2026 meeting minutes be corrected or supplemented to reflect discussion following his public comment regarding the TAP grant sidewalk project overspend. He stated that he understood Council intended to review the process to understand how costs exceeded the original Village share by approximately \$1.2 million and to avoid similar issues with future major projects, including the anticipated 13 Mile Road reconstruction.

BUSINESS AGENDA

AWARD BID FOR INSTALLATION OF BEVERLY PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

Rothe gave an overview of the Beverly Park playground project and stated that the revised project plans expand the turf surfacing to improve accessibility while reducing Village costs below the amount originally authorized. Rothe stated that JSS Macomb LLC was the lowest bidder and upon review met all qualification requirements. Administration and Council discussed project delays, accessibility improvements and project timeline.

Motion by Hrydziuszko, second by Abboud, be it resolved, the Beverly Hills Village Council hereby awards the bid for installation of the Beverly Park Playground to JSS - Macomb, LLC in the amount of \$658,513.61. Funds are available in account #208-900-970.01

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Beverly Hills Village Council authorizes the Finance Director to amend the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget as proposed.

AWARD PROPOSAL FOR VILLAGE MASTER PLAN UPDATE AND ZONING ORDINANCE REWRITE

Rothe gave an overview. Administration received seven RFPs and recommended Giffels Webster due to their integrated approach to the master plan and zoning rewrite, strong community engagement strategy, and experience with Village and Southfield Road corridor. Administration and Council discussed grant approval status, Planning Commission involvement, the difference between a zoning ordinance rewrite and the prior Municode formatting update and the importance of reviewing draft ordinance sections throughout the process.

Motion by Hrydziuszko, second by O’Gorman, BE IT RESOLVED, the Beverly Hills Village Council awards a proposal to Giffels Webster for Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance Rewrite Services, pending final approval from the MEDC on the CDBG Grant.

PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS TO BE ADDED TO THE TAX ROLL

Rothe gave an overview of the special assessments that will be added to the tax roll, totaling approximately \$190,000. Rothe stated that the majority consisted of delinquent utility balances for 119 properties, along with unpaid dust control, Southfield Road maintenance, and sidewalk assessments. Council and Rothe discussed delinquency trends and resident notification procedures, including available assistance resources for qualifying residents.

President George opened the public hearing on 7:51 p.m.

No public comment was offered. President George closed the public hearing at 7:52 p.m.

RESOLUTION ADDING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS TO THE TAX ROLL

Motion by Drummond, second by Hrydziuszko, BE IT RESOLVED, the Beverly Hills Village Council approves the unpaid assessments and billings to be added to the tax roll as outlined above.

PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2027 BUDGET

President George introduced the proposed Fiscal Year 2027 budget and related resolutions. Manager Rothe stated the proposed budget included approximately \$27.2 million in total revenues and \$29.4 million in total expenditures, including depreciation.

President George opened the public hearing on 7:54 p.m.

Patrica Columbo, Marguerite, inquired about the Council packet, taxes and utility bills.

No further public comment was offered. President George closed the public hearing at 7:58 p.m.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING FISCAL YEAR 2027 BUDGET

Rothe stated that this resolution adopts the Fiscal Year 2027 budget at the fund and department level for the General Fund, special revenue funds, and Water and Sewer Fund, serves as the required appropriations act under the Village Charter and Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act.

Motion by Abboud, second by Drummond, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That estimates of anticipated revenues and proposed appropriations are hereby adopted as contained in the accompanying summary documents as follows; and,
2. That estimates of revenues are adopted in total by fund and appropriations are hereby authorized at the department function level (lump sum); and,
3. That estimates of revenues are adopted in total by fund and appropriations are hereby authorized to be cancelled or reallocated at the department function level (lump sum); and,
4. That estimates of revenues are adopted in total and appropriations for remaining governmental funds are approved in total for each fund (lump sum) for the General Fund, all the Special Revenue Funds, and all Proprietary Funds; and,

5. The Village of Beverly Hills Village Council does hereby approve this Resolution authorizing the adoption of the FY2026-2027 Budgets as outlined and attached for all funds in accordance with the terms and conditions contained herein.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING MILLAGE RATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027

Rothe explained that after adopting the budget, Council was required to approve the millage rates needed to generate the necessary revenue. Rothe stated that proposed rates were expected to generate approximately \$11.8 million and all millage rates, except the rubbish millage, were subject to Headlee rollbacks for the 2026 tax year. Rothe stated that following review by Oakland County, the general operating millage rate was slightly adjusted from 1.7509 to 1.7508 mills. Administration and Council discussed how Headlee rollbacks, taxable value increases, property transfers, and new construction can impact property tax bills.

Motion by O’Gorman, second by Hrydziuszko, WHEREAS, the Village Council has adopted its annual budget for its fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, in accordance with State law and the Village Charter; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council must also adopt a millage rate to be levied on the Village tax roll for 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Beverly Hills Village Council hereby approves the total 2026 millage rate for the Village at 13.4316 mills to be distributed as follows:

- General Fund: 1.7508
- Public Safety Fund: 9.2210
- Library Fund: 0.7620
- Park Improvement Fund: 0.2978
- Rubbish Fund: 1.4000

RESOLUTION ADOPTING WATER/SEWER RATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027

Rothe stated that proposed water and sewer rate increases in the Fiscal Year 2027 budget were based on a 2025 rate study and are expected to result in about a 5% quarterly increase for an average resident, or roughly \$7.43 per month, effective July 1, 2026. Rothe explained the utility system requires significant revenue to cover wholesale water and sewer costs and ongoing infrastructure needs, with regional rate increases also contributing. Administration and Council discussed the rate study methodology, cost allocation between fixed and usage charges, and the financial impact on a primarily residential community.

Kevin Jankowski, Mackenzie Court, inquired about the 2025 rate study.

Motion by Mercer, second by Abboud, NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Beverly Hills Village Council as follows:

1. RATES AND CHARGES. The Village Council hereby adopts the rates and charges as attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

2. FEE FOR RETURNED PAYMENT. A fee of \$25.00 shall be charged for any payments of fees pursuant to this Resolution that is returned to the Village for any reason, including, but not limited to, insufficient funds, account closed, or referred to maker.

3. PAYMENT PERIOD; LATE FEES. All bills for Utility Services shall be paid in full within the payment period specified in the bill. The payment period shall be established by the Village Treasurer and shall be no less than 21 or more than 30 days from the date of issuance of the bill. Pursuant to Section 44-25 of the Village Code, if any bill for Utility Services is not paid within the specified payment period, a late payment penalty of 10% of the amount due shall be added to the bill and collected from the user.

4. EFFECT OF RESOLUTION. The rates established in this Resolution shall apply to all Utility Service usage that will be billed by the Village on bills with a billing date on or after July 1, 2026.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A GENERAL FUND BALANCE POLICY

Rothe gave an overview and explained that the policy establishes minimum and target reserve levels for the General Fund to guide future budgeting. Administration and Council discussed balancing fiscal stability and emergency preparedness with resident expectations that tax dollars be used for Village services, and improvements in separate Public Safety and Water/Sewer fund balances.

Motion by Mercer, second by Abboud, BE IT RESOLVED, the Beverly Hills Village Council adopts the proposed General Fund Balance policy as presented.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Rothe went over the Manager's report as provided in the regular Village Council meeting packet. Rothe and Council discussed the 13 Mile resurfacing schedule and traffic impacts. Arnold gave an overview of the April 2026 Public Safety Report.

COUNCIL COMMENTS

Mercer thanked Village Administration and staff for their work on several major annual agenda items and expressed support for the Beverly Park playground project, stating that despite delays and complexities, the completed project would significantly improve the park.

Hrydziuszko thanked the Parks and Recreation Board and volunteers for their work during Park Cleanup and noted that water rate study materials were available in the June 17, 2025 Council packet and video. Hrydziuszko discussed observations from a visit to Dublin, Ohio, which

increased her interest in exploring overlay-style development concepts during the Village's master plan process.

Abboud thanked Administration and reported that SEMCOG had announced a 2027 planning assistance program for local planning projects related to transportation, safety, accessibility, multimodal corridors, pedestrian-friendly streetscapes, trails, stormwater management, and multi-community corridor planning. Abboud also reported on Michigan Municipal League activities, Cable Board discussions regarding the digital divide and financial sustainability, the community center planning process, and an upcoming SMART presentation for seniors and veterans.

Drummond thanked Administration for their work.

George thanked Village staff and department heads for their service and expressed interest in continued discussion of traffic-calming measures and future millage allocation considerations. He also requested careful inspection of Safe Routes to School sidewalk work, thanked Council and staff for advancing the playground project, and noted upcoming community events, including Jazz in the Park.

ADJOURNMENT

Motion by Abboud, second by Hrydziuszko, to adjourn the meeting at 8:59 p.m.

Application for Boards & Commissions



Applying to a Board or Commission

Individuals interested in serving on a Village board, commission, or committee must complete the "Application for Boards and Commissions," indicating the board or commission for which they are applying. Applications are available at the Village Clerk's Office or online at www.beverlyhillsmi.gov. Applications remain active for one year and will be considered by the Village Council if a vacancy becomes available on the selected board or commission.



Appointment Process

Vacancies on Village boards and committees are publicly announced at two consecutive regular Village Council meetings and at the applicable board or committee meeting. Announcements are also posted on the Village website, Facebook page, the Village newsletter and included in the Around the Village e-news blast.

A three-member selection committee is formed to review applications. If a selection committee meeting is held, it will be an open meeting and will be properly posted in advance. Applicants are encouraged to attend, and meetings are scheduled at a time that allows applicants an opportunity to be heard.

The selection committee reviews all submitted applications and may recommend two or three candidates in order of preference. Prior to making a recommendation to the Village Council, the Council liaison consults with the Chairperson of the applicable board or committee.

Final appointments are made by the Village Council. Following Council action, all applicants receive written notification regarding the outcome of their application. Applications of unsuccessful candidates are retained for future consideration and remain active for one year from the date of submission.



Eligibility Requirements

Individuals appointed by the Village Council to serve on boards and standing committees must meet the following requirements:

- Have resided in the Village for at least one year
- Be a qualified and registered voter of the Village of Beverly Hills
- Be able to maintain a minimum 70% annual attendance record
- Agree to abide by the Ethical Standards of Conduct as outlined in the Village of Beverly Hills Organizational and Council Policies and Procedures Manual

Removal for Cause: Members of any board or standing committee may, after a public hearing, be removed for cause by the Village Council.

Summary:

Every other fiscal year, the Department of Public Safety acquires two replacement patrol vehicles. The last purchase occurred in fiscal year 2025, making fiscal year 2027 the next replacement cycle. The vehicles will replace patrol vehicles #310 (72,925 miles) and #309 (73,937 miles), which are nearing the end of their life cycles. Increased maintenance demands over the past five years have resulted from wear and tear.

One of the decommissioned vehicles, a Tahoe, will be repurposed for the School Resource Officer, while the other will be available for the Village's general fleet. Both vehicles will be procured through the Mi-Deal Cooperative Purchasing Program. Necessary equipment outfitting will be performed by Canfield Equipment Services, another participant in the Mi-Deal program. The total expenditure for the two vehicles and their equipment is \$148,781.06.

Summary:

As discussed at the January 2026 study session, the Public Safety Department's ladder truck is nearing the end of its useful life. Replacement trucks currently have a build time of 23 to 25 months. The Department seeks approval to order a Sutphen SL100 Ladder Truck from Apollo Fire Apparatus. This truck has been tailored to meet the specific requirements of the Beverly Hills Public Safety Department, and pricing is available through Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Contract (#082025-SUT). Apollo Fire Apparatus is the local dealer for Sutphen.

Attached to this cover memo is a report authored by Lieutenants Ginther and Moore, providing additional context for the request, along with the plans and specifications for the truck.

Financial Impact:

The cost of the truck is \$1,967,530.65. Payment will not be required until delivery. With an estimated build time of 23 to 25 months from the date of order, this purchase is expected to be accounted for either at the end of the Fiscal Year 2028 budget or at the beginning of the Fiscal Year 2029 budget.

Recommendation:

BE IT RESOLVED, the Beverly Hills Village Council approves the purchase of a Sutphen SL100 Ladder Truck from Apollo Fire Apparatus utilizing Sourcewell Contract #082025-SUT as presented.

RE: Fire apparatus assessment for the purchase of a Ladder Truck



BACKGROUND:

The Beverly Hills Public Safety Department has recently assessed our agency's needs as they apply to fire apparatus and equipment. In doing so, we considered the fire protection and rescue response to not only traditional residential structures, which have significant setbacks from the street; but over 100 commercial businesses, several parks and nature areas that include water hazards, densely wooded areas as well as sections throughout the village that are not easily accessible due to their height.

Within the geographical boundaries of the village is a five story below ground water retention/treatment facility, a pumping station on the Upper Rouge River, a high pressure natural gas/petroleum pipeline, and two water towers that are part of the independent water system for William Beaumont Hospital, the largest Level I Trauma Center for Oakland County.

Also, a designated commercial vehicle route traverses the village for approximately three miles on Southfield and Fourteen Mile Roads. This route includes the transportation of standard cargo and Hazardous Materials; and is the primary commercial vehicle route for East/West transport of explosives and Hazardous Materials that is prohibited from traveling on I-696 due to its underground design.

Furthermore, Beverly Hills Public Safety is a founding member of the South Oakland Fire Association (SOFA), a consortium of nine fire and public safety departments in South-East Oakland County. SOFA was organized in 2013 for the mutually beneficial purposes of Automatic/Mutual Aid, regional grant submissions, and reduced conglomerate pricing for equipment purchasing and training; which necessitates the possibility of supporting a response to the eight other participating municipalities just as they would respond to our community.

Collectively, the SOFA agencies protect over 7,000 commercial businesses, three public golf courses, many parks and nature areas that include water hazards, a below-grade interstate roadway, numerous multi-story senior living facilities and nursing homes, as well as multiple medium-rise buildings up to 25 stories in height, and school buildings that are public, charter, and private school designations, as well as the administrative offices for Berkley, Birmingham, Farmington, Oak Park, and Troy Public Schools.

SOFA departments protect hundreds of multi-family housing apartments and condominium/townhouse complexes, an Amtrak Multi-Modal Transit Facility, a Level II Trauma hospital, and the Detroit Zoo, home to more than 2,400 animals representing over 200 species with an annual attendance of more than 1.5 million visitors sitting on 125 acres.

ASSESSMENT:

In our recent needs assessment of providing fire protection and rescue response to the community; the main deficiency that has been identified is the age of the agency's front line Ladder Truck and no redundant or reserve equipment for this classification.

In an effort to present an objective systematic approach for replacement of apparatus, the American Public Works Association has developed a point system criterion for municipal vehicle replacement, which is outlined in the below table.

Factor	Replacement Point Value		
Age	One point for every year of chronological age, based on in-service date.		
Miles/Hours	One point for each 10,000 miles or 1,000 engine hours of use.		
Type of Service	One, three, or five points are assigned based on the type of service the unit is exposed to. For instance, fire suppression apparatus would be given a five because it is classified as severe duty service. In contrast, an administrative sedan would be given a one.		
Reliability	Points are assigned as one, three, or five depending on the frequency that a vehicle is in the shop for repair. A five would be assigned to a vehicle in the shop two or more times per month on average, while a one would be assigned to a vehicle in the shop an average of once every three months or less.		
M&R Costs	One to five points are assigned based on total life M&R costs (not including repair of accident damage). A five is assigned to a vehicle with life M&R costs equal to or greater than the vehicle's original purchase price, while a one is given to a vehicle with life M&R costs equal to 20 percent or less than its original purchase cost.		
Condition	This category takes into consideration body condition, rust, interior condition, accident history, anticipated repairs, and so on. A scale of one to five points is used with five being poor condition.		
Point Ranges	Fewer than 18 Points	Condition I	Excellent
	18 to 22 points	Condition II	Good
	23 to 27 points	Condition III	Qualifies for replacement
	28 points and above	Condition IV	Needs immediate consideration

Utilizing the above point system, the status of our aerial apparatus, Ladder 34, qualifies for replacement.

COST/BENEFIT:

The quoted cost of a ladder truck is \$1,967,530.65. The benefits of replacing our ladder truck would include locking in current pricing and allows for a 25 month delivery lead time of the replacement apparatus to be a smooth transition of equipment rather than emergent when the vehicle replacement point assessment reaches Condition IV; as well as a significant maintenance cost savings due to the vehicle being new and covered by warranty, in contrast to our current aging vehicle. The replacement ladder truck would respond to approximately 40 percent of our fire and rescue calls for service such as:

- Residential Structure Fires
- Commercial Structure Fires
- Calls for Automatic & Mutual Aid
- Elevated Rescue
- Water Rescue

RECOMMENDATION:

Based upon this assessment, and a long-term vision of providing a high level of fire protection to the residents and those visiting the village, as well as meeting our automatic/mutual aid commitments to our SOFA partners, the following recommendations are put forth for your review.

- Commit to purchase a ladder truck that meets the following criteria:
 - Compliant with NFPA 1901 – Standard on Automotive Fire Apparatus
 - Manufactured by a company with an established reputation in the field of fire apparatus building; has been in business for a minimum of fifty years; has not been part of any bankruptcy reorganization for the same period; and is recognized as a single source manufacturer
 - Will build a ladder truck with at least, but not limited to the following requirements:
 - Capable of carrying 1000ft of 5”LDH in a hose bed and 200ft of 2 ½” hose in a cross lay
 - Have a water tank capable of storing no less than 500 gallons
 - Have a Hale pump capable of pumping no less than 1500GPM
 - Have a mid-mount “huck bolted” aerial ladder of no less than 100ft, w/master stream
 - Have a compartment mounted to one side of the aerial ladder that stores a “Stokes” Rescue Basket, w/the basket to be included with delivery of the apparatus
 - Have seats for four firefighters wearing personal protective equipment, which do not have SCBA brackets, in a custom cab
 - Have a Cummins diesel engine/transmission appropriate for the workload of the apparatus
 - Have compartment space capable of carrying all current appliances, hand tools, fans, cribbing, extrication equipment and power tools for firefighting operations

Furthermore, it is recommended that we purchase a Sutphen SL100 Ladder Truck for the following reasons:

- Sutphen Fire Apparatus is already an approved vendor of the cooperative bidding process
- We currently operate a Sutphen HDCE Engine and will benefit from:
 - Standardization for operators due to already being familiar with Sutphen controls and chassis
 - Standardized fleet M&R process of having the same manufacturer for multiple fire apparatus
 - Increased operational efficiency by having a mid-mount ladder which places the aerial turntable and controls directly behind the cab, thus moving the controls closer to the pump panel, which will allow the operator to directly oversee both operations of pumping water and aerial controls simultaneously
 - Reduced footprint for the outriggers utilized to stabilize the aerial apparatus which will improve accessibility on residential and congested commercial streets

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Changes to National Fire Protection Association ("NFPA") 1900, Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") or changes legislated by Federal, State or Local Governments or changes in parts availability or vendor relationships that impact the cost to manufacture the truck may incur additional charges which shall be borne by the Purchaser. These may include but are not limited to changes that affect the major vendors of the fire apparatus industry such as pump manufacturers, seat manufacturers, electrical power supplies (generators) and powertrain (engine & transmission). Any such changes shall be documented on a change order executed by both Sutphen and Purchaser.

Sutphen shall provide written notice to the Purchaser as soon as it reasonably believes any cost increase provision may be invoked. Sutphen shall provide, upon written request, documentation of such changes and increases.

Sutphen will use its reasonable best efforts to deliver the apparatus within the timeframe quoted herein, provided that such delivery date shall be automatically extended for delays beyond Sutphen's control, including, without limitation, strikes, labor disputes, riots, civil unrest, pandemics, war or other military actions, sabotage, government regulations or controls, fire or other casualty, or inability to obtain materials or services. If such delay occurs, Sutphen shall give notice of delay to Purchaser. Purchaser shall not be entitled to any discount or reduction in price for such delay and Sutphen shall not be liable for any damages (compensatory, incidental, consequential or otherwise) related to such delay.

Final payment shall be made at the time of final inspection at the factory. Should payment be delayed, Sutphen reserves the right to charge interest at the rate of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month, beginning on the day after payment is due.

Delivery, payment, and transfer of the Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (MCO) shall take place at Sutphen during final inspection, and upon payment in full in accordance with these terms. Sutphen reserves the right to withhold delivery of the MCO until payment in full is received. If Purchaser requires any third-party equipment mounting, the apparatus shall be moved to the third-party facility by the dealer or Purchaser for such mounting. Such third-party work shall not delay or offset payment to Sutphen. The apparatus shall be tested per NFPA #1900 at Sutphen's manufacturing facility. Purchaser agrees that the apparatus and equipment being purchased hereunder shall not be driven or used in any manner until it is paid for in full. In the event there are any shortages or omissions with the apparatus at time of completion, Purchaser may withhold a sum equivalent to the price of any such shortages as determined by Sutphen.

In the case of any default in payment hereunder or in the payment on any notes, negotiable paper, obligations or other instruments issued by Purchaser, Sutphen may take full possession of the apparatus and equipment or of the piece or pieces upon which default has been made, and any payments that have been made theretofore shall be applied as rent in full for the use of the apparatus and equipment up to the date of taking possession by Sutphen.

Sutphen warrants to Purchaser that all goods and services furnished hereunder will conform in all respects to the terms of this order, including any applicable change orders, drawings, specifications, or standards incorporated herein, and/or shall be free of defects in materials, workmanship, and free from such defects in design. In addition, Sutphen warrants that the goods and services are suitable for and will perform in accordance with the purposes for which they were intended, for a period of one year from the Warranty Registration Date, unless an extended warranty is purchased.

The purchase price provided for herein does not include any federal, state or local sales tax, duties, imposts, revenues, excise or other taxes which may hereafter be imposed by governmental authority or otherwise and which are made applicable to the apparatus or equipment covered by this Proposal. In the event that any such taxes are subsequently imposed and become applicable, the purchase price herein shall be increased by the amount of such taxes and such sum shall be immediately paid by Purchaser to Sutphen. To the extent applicable, the prices and deliveries set forth herein are subject to the Defense Production Act.

Sutphen shall provide insurance insuring the apparatus and equipment against loss by fire, theft, or collision and insuring against property damage and personal injury through the completion of the apparatus and transfer of the Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin.

After the execution of this Agreement, Purchaser shall have no right to terminate the Agreement. Sutphen may, in its absolute and sole discretion, accept Purchaser's request to terminate the Agreement. In the event Sutphen accepts Purchaser's request to terminate the Agreement, Sutphen may charge a cancellation fee. The following charge schedule based on costs incurred may be applied, at Sutphen's sole discretion: (a) 10% after order is accepted by Sutphen; (b) 30% of the Purchase Price after production has commenced. The cancellation fee may increase accordingly as costs are incurred as the order progresses through engineering and into manufacturing.

These Terms and Conditions ("T&C") contained in the Proposal provided herein take precedence over all previous negotiations, oral or written, and no representations or warranties are applicable except as specifically contained in these or in any subsequently signed agreement between the Parties. No waiver of any of the provisions of these T&C shall be deemed a waiver of any other provision, whether similar, nor shall any waiver constitute a continuing waiver. If a Purchase Order is issued, this Proposal, including the Terms and Conditions contained herein, shall supersede the terms in the Purchase Order where terms may be inconsistent.

This Proposal shall be governed and controlled as to interpretation, enforcement, validity, construction, effect and in all other respects by the laws, statutes, and decisions of the State of Ohio. Exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any litigation at all related to this in the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, Columbus, Ohio, and the parties hereto consent and submit to the general jurisdiction of this court. All of these T&C shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of and be enforceable by Sutphen, Purchaser, their successors and assigns.

SUBJECT: Proposed Ordinance Amending Chapter 8, “Animals”

Attached for Council’s consideration for first reading is a proposed ordinance amending Chapter 8 of the Village Code of Ordinances, which is proposed to address the issues discussed with Council in closed sessions on April 7th and 21st, 2026.

The ordinance contains two proposed amendments. The first would amend Article I, and create a limited exception for residents who were in possession of more animals (dogs, cats or hen chickens) at the effective date of the amendments to Chapter 8 (adopted last year) than are now permitted. Proposed new Section 8-14 allows that residents may keep animals in excess of those now permitted until the end of that animal’s natural life. After the number of animals is reduced to the permitted number, the resident may only have the number of animals permitted in Chapter 8.

A second proposed amendment amends Article III, Section 8-62, and gives the Village discretion to allow a larger coop or pen for a resident who qualifies for a limited exception under Section 8-14, and who demonstrates they are in need of more space to house their hen chickens.

All provisions regarding licensing, permitting, etc., contained in Chapter 8 remain in full force and effect. The amendment adds provisions to deal with nuisance conditions, as well as residents who continue to acquire even more animals.

As you are aware, the Village Charter requires a minimum of two readings of an ordinance. Therefore, once the Council is satisfied with the proposed amendments, I would recommend a formal motion to introduce the amendment and hold a first reading.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS, MICHIGAN,
BY AMENDING CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE I, TO ADD A NEW
SECTION 8-15, ENTITLED “LIMITED EXCEPTION,” AND TO
AMEND CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE III, SECTION 8-62.

The Village of Beverly Hills Ordains:

Section 1 of the Ordinance

The Code of Ordinances of the Village of Beverly Hills, Chapter 8, Article I, is hereby amended to add a new Section 8-15 to read as follows:

Sec. 8-15. Limited Exception.

- (a) This section creates a limited exception to the maximum number of animals that may be kept under this chapter.
- (b) Any person(s) who was in possession of more animals than are permitted to be kept on residential property under this chapter as of October 7, 2025, shall be permitted to keep said animals through the end of the animals’ natural life. Upon reduction of a resident’s animal(s) to the maximum number permitted under this chapter, such person shall not be permitted to keep more than the maximum number of animals authorized by the Village at any time.
- (c) All dogs kept by a resident must be licensed in accordance with this chapter.
- (d) If person is found to have acquired more animals at any time after October 7, 2026, such person shall be required to immediately reduce the number of animals on their property to the maximum number permitted under this Article.
- (e) To the extent the keeping of more than the maximum number of permitted animals results in nuisance conditions as defined in the Village Code, a written notice of intent to terminate the applicable license(s) or permit for the excess animals shall be sent by the

Village. The resident may request a hearing before the Village Council challenging the notice to terminate. Failure to request a hearing within 30 days of the date of the notice of intent shall result in a revocation of the license(s) or permit, and the Village may proceed with appropriate enforcement action.

(f) Residents who qualify for an exception under this section are still required to comply with all the requirements found in this chapter and elsewhere in the Village Code related to the keeping of animals.

Section 2 of the Ordinance

The Code of Ordinances of the Village of Beverly Hills, Chapter 8, Article III, Section 8-62, is hereby amended to add a new subsection (i) to read as follows:

Sec. 8-63. – Coops and pens.

(a) – (h) [No change.]

(i) Limited exception. For any resident who qualifies for a limited exception under section 8-15 of this code from the maximum number of hen chickens permitted under this Article III, the Village may, in its sole discretion, allow a larger coop or pen to accommodate the additional chickens.

Section 3 of the Ordinance

If any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, void, illegal or ineffective by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such selection, clause or provision declared to be unconstitutional, void or illegal shall thereby cease to be a part of this Ordinance, but the remainder of the Ordinance shall stand and be in full force and effect.

Section 4 of the Ordinance

This Ordinance shall take effect following publication in the manner prescribed by law.

Section 5 of the Ordinance

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect

General Updates

- The Village Council will receive a presentation from the **DNR** about **deer management strategies at its June 2nd Council meeting**. In anticipation of high attendance, the meeting will **be held in the little theatre at Groves High School**.
- The **Beverly Park playground** will begin with mobilization of equipment on Tuesday May 26th, construction is expected to be complete on July 22nd, a pre-construction meeting was held on May 11th to review the schedule and project scope.
- A final punch list has been prepared for the **Pierce Watermain Project**, and the second and final application for Federal grant funds is anticipated to be made this week.
- **SmithGroup** continues to work on the **site analysis and building assessment package**, developing high level conceptual and programmatic options for the future use of the **Wendbrook property**. A presentation/update is expected at the May Parks Board meeting.
- The contractor for the **Safe Routes to School project** completed their walk throughs with Village staff last week. They are expected to be onsite finishing the remaining section of sidewalk and well as conducting required restoration and driveway adjustments this week.
- Village Administration is preparing to **discuss the Village's millage structure and fund balance levels** as part of the Council's ongoing desire to review the Village's long-term financial and service-level goals.
- A kick-off meeting with Giffels Webster staff on the **Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance** rewrite project will occur the morning of May 18th.
- The **RFP for the FY 2027 sidewalk replacement program** has been completed and will be posted in the coming days and responses due in June.

- The **RFP for the Beverly Park fence project** has been completed and will be posted in the coming days and responses are due in June.
- A policy for installation of **traffic calming devices** local Village roads is being drafted.
- **Public Works** current projects include:
 - Foundations for this year's Sculptures in the Park program have been installed.
 - Spring mulching was installed at Village Hall, Public Safety Building, Beverly Park, and Southfield Township.
 - The parking lot at Beverly Park will have the spaces freshly painted in advance of Memorial Day.
- **New signage** at the Public Safety Building is being installed.
- **BS&A Cloud** is set to **go live in July**. The Village's current system will be down for three days in the conversion process, and it is anticipated that Village Hall will be closed to the public for two of these days as staff receive training on the new system. More information is forthcoming.
- **Union negotiations** with the **Command Officers** will occur on May 28th to review a proposed have produced a tentative agreement.
- In May the **Zoning Board of Appeals** denied a previously tabled dimensional variance from its March 9th meeting and adopted Bylaws. The ZBA will not meet in June, as no variance applications were submitted before the deadline.
- The **Planning Commission** met on April 22nd to consider a sign permit for **Detroit County Day**, for a new scoreboard. The application was ultimately tabled and will be reconsidered at the Commission's May meeting.

PROJECT UPDATES

Transportation Alternatives Program Sidewalks

Last week Toebe Construction (the general contractor) continued to install sidewalk on Evergreen Road and started to perform work along 13 Mile Road. This week Toebe is schedule to perform the following work (weather permitting):

Evergreen

- Rouge grade along Evergreen Road between Beverly and Riverside.
- Continue to form and pour sidewalk, ramps, and curb in various areas
- Complete the retaining wall along Evergreen Road.
- Restoration on sidewalk areas that are complete.



13 Mile

- Continue to excavate for retaining walls along 13 Mile Road
- Begin retaining wall installation at 13 Mile and Stafford and possibly at 13 Mile and Rivers Edge.
- Start to rouge grade for the proposed sidewalk (starting at Evergreen working towards west Village limits).

In order to safely perform the proposed work along Evergreen Road, the contractor will need to perform intermittent daily road closures of Evergreen Road. All driveways will be accessible, however, though traffic will not be permitted. After each working day, Evergreen Road will be opened to traffic until the next morning (or when necessary).

FY25/26 Road Improvement Project

The contractor will be back in the spring to complete minor punch list work and install/touch-up any turf grass areas that have not been established. A structure adjustment needs to be made in the RCOC right-of-way at Birwood and Greenfield. Additionally, the southwest corner of Birwood and Greenfield is being reevaluated as ponding has been occurring.
